Too "Twilight"-y for me Von Mina A few years ago I read the "Twilight" series and although it was a guilty pleasure even then, it definitely was a pleasure: I was emotionally gripped and immersed in the story, the love, the characters. Nowadays, after having read YA by Maggie Stiefvater, Cassandra Claire, Bree Despain or Jeri Smith-Ready, I know what the real stuff is and probably wouldn't rate the vampire series equally high. But one thing never changed: Twilight had all that is necessary to make me addicted to it and was better than a lot of what was written seemingly following the "Twilight"-scheme. Meaning a young, totally inexperienced heroine who feels insecure and is rather self-conscious meets the dark, brooding and incredibly handsome guy who could have them all, but is inexplicably interested in said insecure and plain heroine. They grow to love each other in no time, feel the "soul-mate connection" and then all the dark secrets get into the open, accompanied by a lot of teenage angst... you get my meaning. I realize right now that I didn't want to sound so deadpan, but after having read so many YA and other fantasy, I'm just done with the Mary Sues of the genre and the lies and the overabundance of teenage angst. The story and the greater picture are interesting enough: Alexis and her mother move houses across the continent rather constantly and Alexis knows that there is a lot of weird about her mother, who doesn't age and is incredibly strong and herself, since she heals wounds in the blink of an eye and has her moments of being equally strong when being angry. Her mother postpones telling Alexis about themselves, saying she isn't allowed to tell yet. And as a reader, I was as interested as Alexis is, about who and what she and her mother are. But other than the reader, when clues appear, Alexis is not able to put anything together. Not. A. Single. Piece. And that annoyed me to no end. She is the epitome of all I can't put up with a heroine: a Mary Sue if there ever was one. She is 18, has no clue as to the practicalities of s\*\*. Meaning, she doesn't even theoretically know what it entails. Oh my. And at her age, she has never spent one single night without her mother. WTF! The rest of the story is solidly told and made me want to know, what would happen - but then again, the similarities to the "Twilight"-series, which I won't tell, because I'm afraid that would really spoil too much. But as I said: what made me feel with Bella Swan is missing here. I was told about the love, I didn't feel it. The other characters, besides the hero Tristan, stay a bit colourless too, but then it's a series and there is enough potential to flesh them fully out in the future. And the overall story arc actually is really good and did interest me a lot. If not for Alexis' character, it would have been enough to keep me hanging on. But I rolled my eyes so many times and found myself shouting at my Kindle that I accept that this just isn't my cup of tea.
