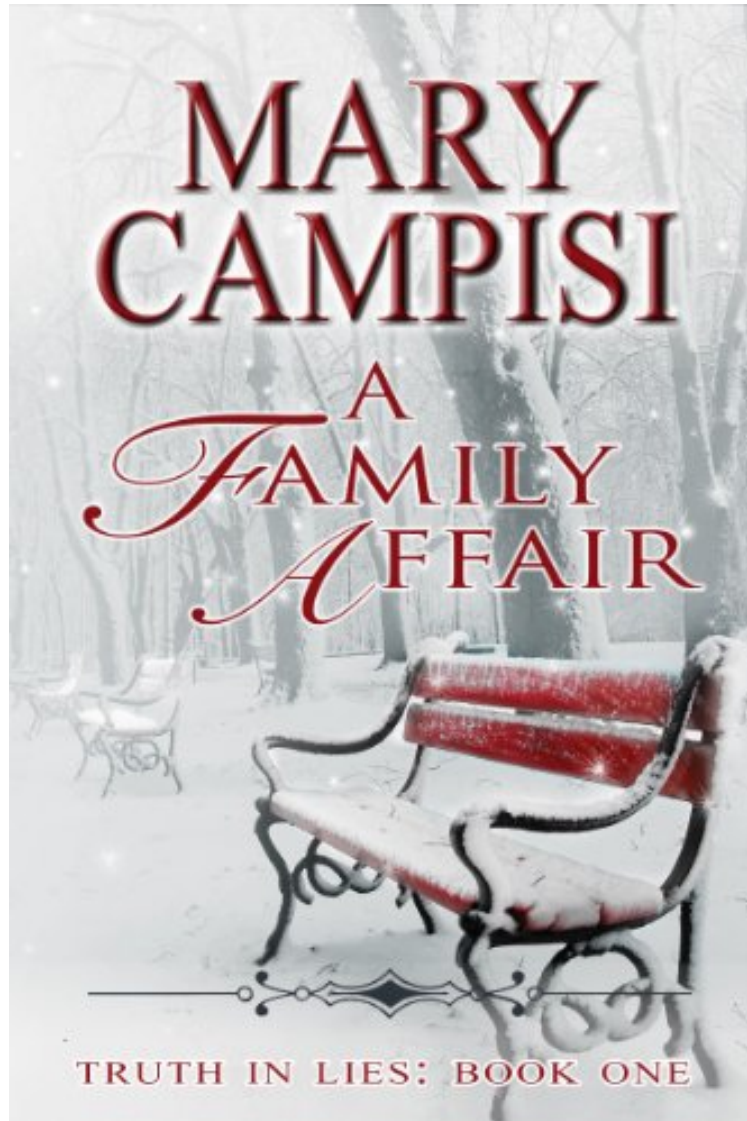

Von CoffeeAndBooks Meine Rezension zu A Family Affair von Mary Campisi fällt zwiespältig aus. Einerseits denke ich, dass das Buch ein großes Potenzial hat/hatte - es aber leider nicht ausgenutzt hat und andererseits gab es Momente wo ich dachte "What a mess" - was für ein Kuddelmuddel! Die Geschichte dreht sich um Christine, die erfährt dass ihr Vater ein Doppelleben mit einer zweiten Familie geführt hat und wie ihr Leben durch diese Erkenntnis eine andere Wendung nimmt. Ich finde, dass das Familiendrama im Großen sehr gefühlvoll und realistisch erzählt wurde, Mary Campisi schreibt es wirklich sehr packend. Allerdings auch einseitig - schnell ist klar dass die Ehefrau ein eiskaltes, manipulatives Miststück ist und "the other woman", die Affäre anscheinend die wahre Liebe von Christine's Vater. Ich will hier nicht die große Moralkeule schwingen, aber es ist kein bisschen Reue da oder auch ansatzweise zu erkennen dass es falsch war, sich wissentlich an einen verheirateten Mann heran zu machen - die Entschuldigung "ich konnte nicht anders" kommt oft im Buch vor und ist schlichtweg dümmlich. Sehr bläss fand ich auch die Hauptperson Christine, sie lässt sich emotional von ihrer Mutter ausnutzen und bietet niemanden richtig Paroli, weder ihrem versnobten Freund noch Nate (dessen Mutter die Affäre mit Christine's Vater hatte). Wie sie es geschafft hat an die Spitze einer Firma zu kommen ist mir ein Rätsel. Unausgereift ist auch die Liebesgeschichte zwischen Christine und Nate - mir ist schon klar, dass es ein Happy End am Ende geben sollte, aber es kommen noch weitere Handlungsstränge hinzu (Beziehungen zwischen Christine's Mutter und Onkel, ihre Halbschwester, Liebesgeschichte, berufliche Veränderung und noch mehr) die einfach viel zu viel und verwirrend sind. Die Geschichte hat mehr Tiefe verdient und so wie Mary Campisi schreibt, kann sie das durchaus - was für mich um so frustrierender war. Das Buch hätte meiner Meinung nach noch einige Kapitel mehr gebraucht um richtig zur "Geltung" zu kommen, die Grundgeschichte ist interessant: was man aus so einer Ausgangslage machen kann hat Gromeisterin Nora Roberts mit der "Born in" Triologie bereits brilliant gezeigt.
