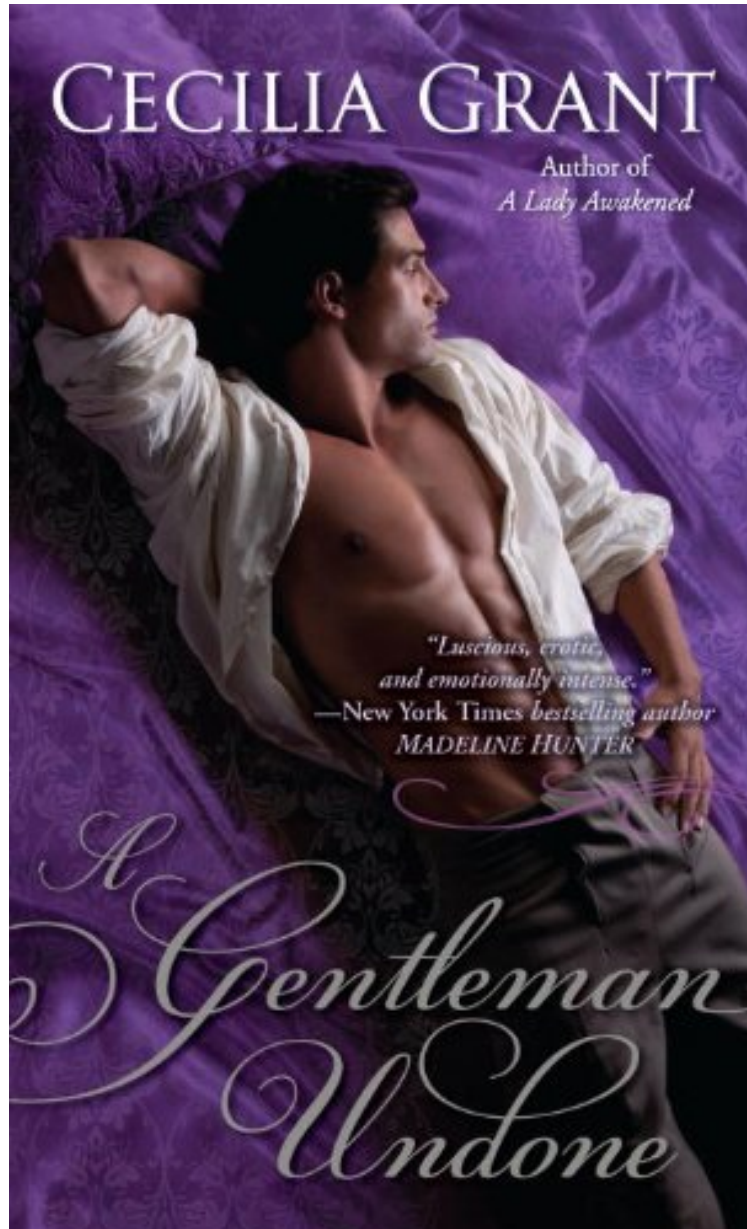

Will, our hero, returns from the Battle of Waterloo with something close to PTSD, and he has persuaded himself that he must find money to provide a pension for the widow of one of his men, who died basically in his arms. Will blames himself for not having saved this man - in fact, he obsesses over it, which is not quite believable; after all, this is war, and he only tried to help. To make money, Will starts playing cards in a gaming hell, where he meets Lydia, a courtesan who is pretty sharp with the cards, and with her tongue. Lydia is an unusual romantic heroine - you could say there is very little "romantic" about her at first. But you understand why she is doing what she's doing. The only historically and/or psychologically implausible things were that Lydia hasn't caught any kind of STD (in real life, she would have been infected with syphilis five times over), and that Will doesn't feel even a second of revulsion at a woman who has had sex with some many different men. But it would be ungrateful to quibble, when Cecilia Grant has dared to write such an enjoyable and courageously unconventional novel in what is often described as an exhausted genre, the Regency novel. And the love scenes are really hot ;-))
