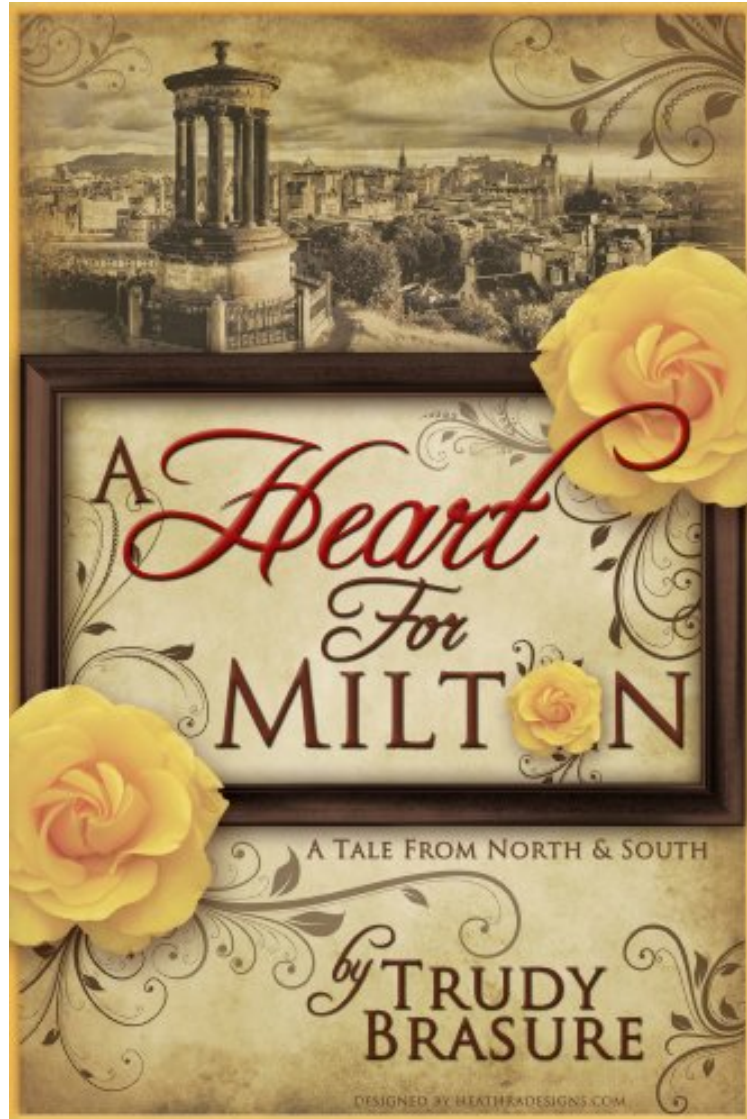

I bought the book because I loved "North and South" and greatly adored the film hoping for the story of Margaret and Mr. Thornton to go on a little. Both the book and the film presented a relationship which was

either marked by them showing two very strong-headed characters in conversation or by meaningful glances they exchanged. You could easily feel with the characters and the descriptions and pictures left a lot of space for imagination. In this book the love story is neither exciting nor does it leave any room for the reader's imagination. Everything is so plainly laid out and repeated a hundred times until you don't really want to hear any more about it. Margaret and Mr. Thornton are turned into two creatures helplessly fallen in love and not able to think of anything else for weeks. In "North and South" there was the great story of the industrial revolution woven into the story of Margaret and Mr. Thornton. The lives and conditions of workers in Milton, the gloomy atmosphere and the great differences between Margaret's and Mr. Thornton's lives made the book interesting. I'm only half-way through this book so far but there's no story at all but two people always pledging their deepest feelings to each other. This does not match with the proud and strong-minded characters of Gaskell's novel nor does it meet the gorgeous performances of Daniela Denby-Ashe and Richard Armitage in the film as the writer tried to do. I appreciate the attempt to let us dream on with Margaret and Mr. Thornton but it is not well done. If you like people openly announcing their love for each other over and over again it's the right book for you. If you like a story worth reading and characters realistically and carefully portrayed - don't buy it!

Die eigentliche Geschichte zu North and South hat für meinen Geschmack nämlich viel zu plötzlich auf, so dass man zwar das ganze Drama durchlitten hat, die "Belohnung" aber ausbleibt. Das wird nun in dieser Fortsetzung ausgiebig nachgeholt. Der Schreibstil liest sich sehr gut und passt sich sehr gut dem originalen Schreibstil von Elisabeth Gaskell an.
