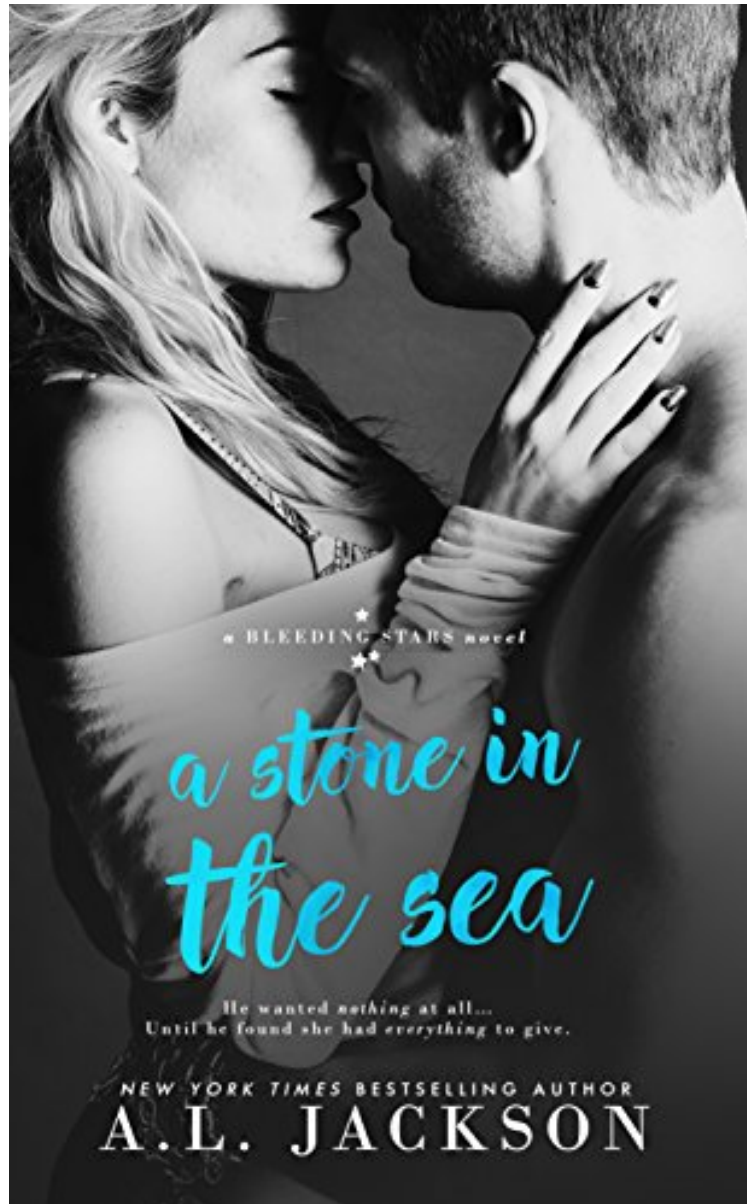

Die Story wird abwechselnd aus Sebastians und Sheas Sicht erzht. In diesem Teil geht es in erster Linie um die Entwicklung der Beziehung zwischen Sebastian und Shea. Besonders Sebastians Erzhlstrnge sind sehr schwermtig. Aber auch Shea hat mit ihrer Vergangenheit zu kmpfen und will sich anfangs nicht auf Sebastian einlassen. Die Atmosphre des Buches - bestehen aus dieser Schwermtigkeit und sexuellen Anziehungskraft zwischen Sebastian und Shea - hat mir sehr gut gefallen. Auch die Charaktere von Sebastian und Shea waren intensiv und gut ausgearbeitet und konnten mich emotional berhrt. Leser, die eine leichtfssige Lektre fr zwischendurch suchen, wrde ich dieses Buch nicht empfehlen. Der Schreibstil war zum grten Teil flssig. Zum Teil auch staccato-mig. Das htte mich eigentlich nicht gestrt, wenn zum Ende hin nicht zu oft Wrter oder Stze dreimal hintereinander von den Protagonisten wiederholt worden wren. Dies ist aber nur ein kleines Manko und hat meinen insgesamt positiven Eindruck nicht groartig geschmlert. Anfangs haben mir die Sprecher nicht so gut gefallen. Jedoch muss ich im nachhinein sagen, dass beide Sprecher diese dstere und knisternde Atmosphre sehr gut wiedergegeben haben. Fr mich war es daher ein intensives Hrerlebnis.
