Both H/h needed some development, in the beginning, both sounded rather superficial and their motivations shallow, however, this was very nicely shown step by step through their Actions - how they really were under the everyday acting they were both doing. Some obvious romance tropes were avoided, the way the Heroine reacted, when she made a very bad mistake that seemed a betrayal, was lovely in its consistent good reaction (no Drama, no despair and apathy, just acting to fix things in a reasoned way), the way the Hero developed over the book - nicely done. The London theatre Setting was enjoyable, it sounded convincing to me, the whole description of fame and how to act around it (checking facebook etc.) seemed logical for the setting, and the descriptions of thoughts and personalities there made sense for the Setting, I do not know it myself, but it seemed "right", not just a randomly Chosen Background that added nothing to the Story (as often happens).
