Juliet, the youngest sister, who had been abducted by mysterious Morgan Pryce in 'A Notorious Love.' Now, two years after the dreadful incident, gossip starts to spread among London's ton, thus Juliet decides to finally face down the man responsible for the damage to her reputation. Since she has to live with the consequences, she feels she has a right to know the reasons for the betrayal of the only man she ever fancied herself in love with. However, instead of Morgan Pryce, Juliet encounters his twin brother Sebastian, Lord Templemore, whom she immediately recognizes as her abductor: only nobody wants to believe her! While attempting to trick Sebastian into an acknowledgment of his guilt, Juliet falls again for the man who has vowed to never let love enter his life. The dialogues between Juliet and Sebastian are fast and witty; Juliet's sister Rosalind and her brother-in-law Griff Knighton (both known from the first book of the trilogy) are mostly delightful, sometimes a little annoying secondary characters; and there are some entertaining allusions to other Sabrina Jeffries novels, e.g. 'The Pirate Lord.' Unfortunately there were several passages that required the reader to have previously read the prequels to the book for proper appreciation. Further I kind of missed the appearance of Helena and Daniel from the second volume, whose story I enjoyed best so far! All in all, I really liked the book and devoured it in almost one session. I would, however, really recommend to read the prequels first.

This book which is the third in the series finally deals with Lady Juliet who had been abducted in book no.2. Now two years later she is still trying to get over the man who kidnapped her.
