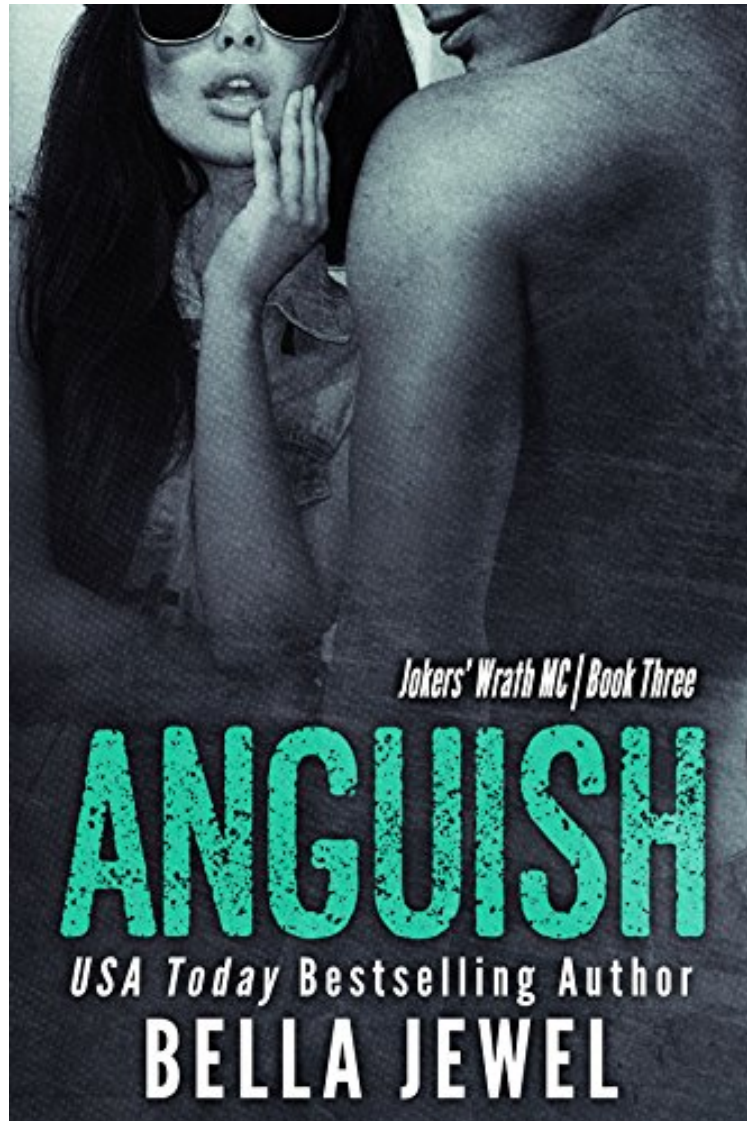

It was so much fun to read, despite some

minor hang-ups I had. We've met Mack in Melancholy as he returned to the Jokers Wrath MC and to his brother Maddox. In Melancholy we've got to know him as a very gentle, sweet and caring man who was one of the main reasons for Santana making it through the tragedy and despair she was in. Anguish shows us a man who when it comes to his own heart and his feelings, can be hard, distant and even mean. Suddenly confronted with the responsibility of single fatherhood, he wants nothing to do with his son Diesel. He doesn't hold him, doesn't talk to him or even so much as look at him. As much as this behavior wanted me to hate him, it was clear he had reasons for it. It was obvious, his heart was so broken, that he didn't have the strength of courage to give it to anyone not even his son. The memory of abandonment and loss too fresh in his heart and soul, he can't risk it to love anyone. But he hasn't taken Jaylah into account the woman he hires as a nanny for Diesel. She pushes him to the point of insanity and manages to get under his skin, without him even noticing. His rough and harsh behavior softens step by step, without him losing the alpha dominant possessive traits. He is sexy as sin and he gets even sexier once the ice around his heart starts melting. Once he is at risk of losing first his son, then Jaylah, he realizes that life is too short to live it in fear. But will the realization be in time? Jaylah is the woman who cracks the hard shell that is Mack. She is a young woman with a sassy mouth and a feisty attitude who got herself into a load of trouble that could end deadly for her, if she doesn't get some money. That is why she takes on the job as Diesel's nanny, not being aware that this will put her on the path to the Jokers Wrath MC and Mack. Her ineptitude to take care of a baby makes for some truly hilarious moments at the beginning of her nanny job, but quickly she learns how to care for Diesel and just as quickly loses her heart to the little boy.
