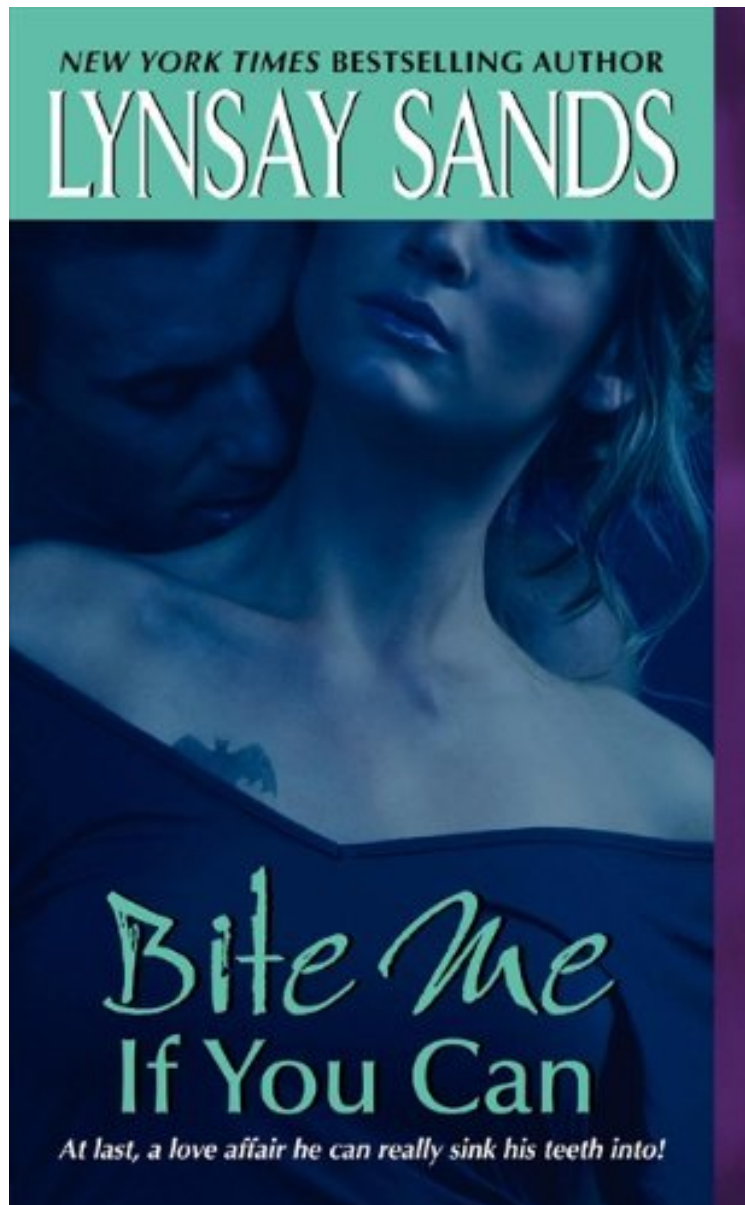

Argeneaus bekannt, muss mal wieder ein Nest abtrnniger Vampire ausruchern. Unter den Vampiren ist Leigh, die gerade erst von Morgan, dem Anfrhrer der Abtrnnigen, verwandelt wurde. Da sie gezwungen wurde, sein Blut zu trinken und keine Vampirgesetze verletzt hat, wird sie nicht bestraft und Lucian fliegt mit ihr nach Toronto, um sie bei seiner Schwgerin abzuliefern, die sich um sie kmmern soll. Doch Marguerite ist auf dem Weg nach Europa und Lucian bleibt nichts anderes brig, als sich selbst der jungen Frau anzunehmen, und ihr alles beizubringen, was sie fr ihr neues Leben wissen muss. Leigh, die vor ihrem brutalen Ehemann davongelaufen ist, und gerade erst begonnen hatte, ihr Leben in den Griff zu bekommen, hasst es, auf Lucian angewiesen zu sein, auch wenn er sehr charmant und liebenswert ist. Sie fhlt sich mehr und mehr zu ihm hingezogen, hat aber Angst, sich auf eine Beziehung einzulassen, und erneut einen Fehler zu machen. Lucian, der Kontakte zu anderen auf ein Minimum beschrnkt und seine Unnahbarkeit pflegt, merkt, wie Leigh seine rauhe Schale nach und nach aufbricht. Nach langer Zeit fhlt er sich wieder zu einer Frau hingezogen, ist jedoch unsicher, da er ihre Gedanken nicht lesen kann und zudem um ihre persnlichen Probleme wei. "Bite Me If You Can" ist der sechste Band um die Argeneau-Familie und vielleicht der beste bisher. Leigh und Lucian und ihre Beziehung zueinander sind sehr berzeugend und mit Morgan hat die Geschichte einen Bsewicht, der nicht zu viel Platz einnimmt, und trotzdem bedrohlich wirkt. Wie bei den anderen Bnden der Serie kommt auch der Humor nicht zu kurz, so dass "Bite Me If You Can" rundherum gute Unterhaltung bietet. 2 von 2 Kunden fanden die folgende Rezension hilfreich. Another instalment in the Argeneau Vampires series Von Helen Hancox This is another book in Lynsay Sands' Argeneau Vampires series although it's not necessary to have read the others to understand this one. The family tree at the beginning of this book gives you a clue that there are a lot of people involved in the plot and indeed there are but it doesn't get confusing as the characters from former books generally have walk-on parts rather than being central to the plot. Leigh Gerard is minding her own business walking home late at night when she's attacked by a vampire and taken away by him to his lair. She manages to escape one of her guards and is on her way out of the house where she's been stashed when she finds that a group of three different men are attacking the house. She's rescued as most of the other vampires are destroyed but it soon becomes apparent that she's been made into a vampire and is 'turning', a very painful and noisy experience. Lucien Argeneau is a bossy, grumpy and arrogant vampire who doesn't really care for anyone since his wife and children died hundreds of years ago. He finds himself having to take care of Leigh, much against his will, whilst she turns. Initially his care for her is fairly perfunctory but soon he finds he's getting more involved and then when she wakes up properly and has lots of questions he's the only person around to help her with the answers. Leigh opens out the world to him a little more, introducing him to the delights of eating real food and of underwear shopping. It becomes clear fairly early on that she is his 'life mate' so there's not much "will they/won't they" tension in the story, more "when will they". There's a subplot of the rogue vampire who turned Leigh chasing her but that's a minor part of the story and it's half-heartedly tacked onto the end to give the book a bit more of a rousing ending. This book had a lot of similarities with Love Bites, another of the Argeneau Vampire series that I've read, in that most of the book revolves around the new vampire learning to live with her status and getting to know the hero. There's little tension in the love story, it's always clear they'll end up together, even the characters themselves know it; there are a few cheap jokes at Lucian's expense (he's had a rather long period of celibacy) and Leigh has a few more sparky moments when her self-defence training comes into play but overall this is a rather unmemorable book with a little characterisation, a little plot and a lot of filler. From Publishers Weekly Sands's delightful sixth visit with the Argeneaus (following A Bite to Remember), a clan of vampires living across present-day North America, features bitter, world-weary Lucian, a bloodsucker preoccupied with hunting down rogue vamps to protect the family and to hide centuries-old grief for his dead wife and children. The depressed vampire

finds a new lease on immortality when he becomes involved with Leigh Gerard, an independent woman fleeing an abusive relationship and looking to make a fresh start in Kansas City. After Leigh is attacked and turned by a wayward vampire named Morgan, Lucian becomes her unwilling tutor in the vampiric lifestyle. When he realizes he's falling in love with her, he has to figure out how to become the kind of man she could fall in love with as well the kind of man he used to be. Though Sands doesn't have much of an antagonist in Morgan, her trademark humor and genuine characters easily carry the romance, and she's able to work in some creative twists on the standard vampire legend, keeping her series fresh and her readers hooked.
