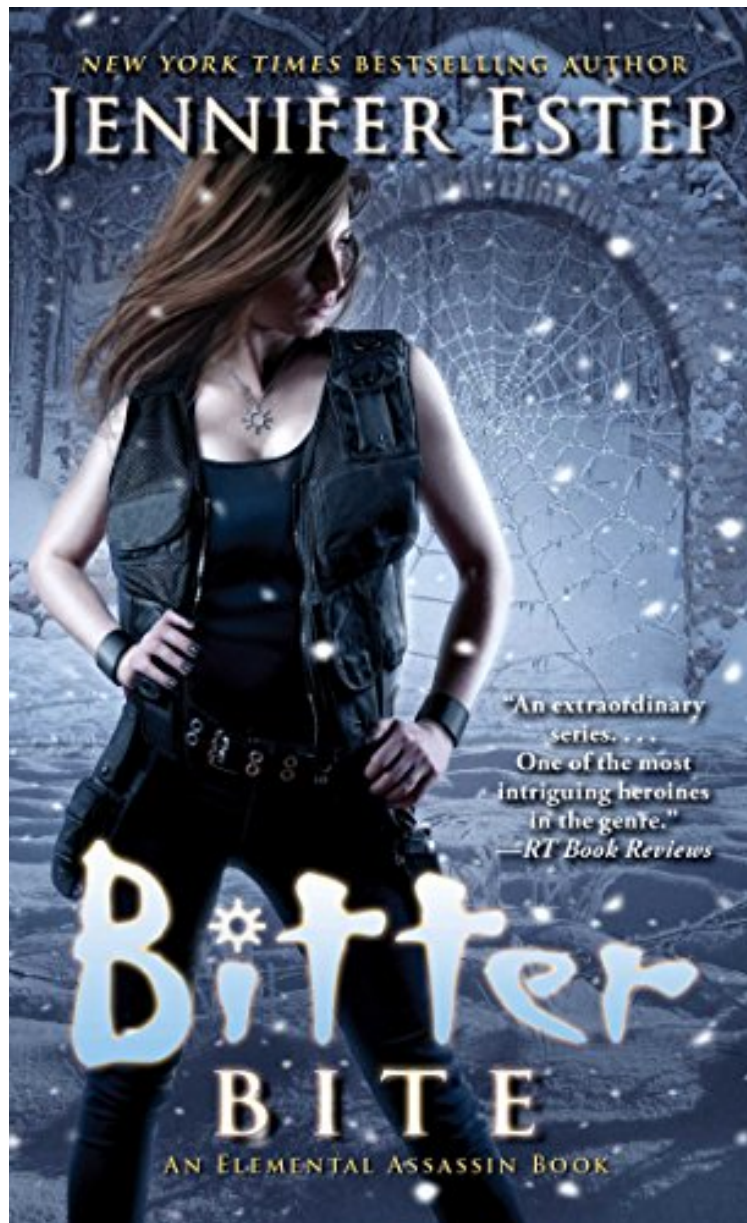

So if you're new to it I recommend to start at the beginning. Review I'm so glad that Gin once more got an impressive, cunning and powerful adversary! I was a bit worried after Spider's Trap, because her opponent there was a bully, but nothing to write home about in the hazard-department, if you get my meaning. But J. Estep rectified that big time here. Because just when Gin finds late Fletcher's warnings about Finn's supposedly dead, but indeed very alive mother, she appears. And Finn is so incredibly happy about her appearance that he is deaf to all of Gin's warnings. And Mama Dee is good, really good at showing a sincere and caring front. So good indeed that Gin starts wondering, if it's her. If she herself is jealous and therefore rejects the possibility that people can change. And it is heartbreaking to see Gin suffer: she is doubting her own thoughts and perceptions, afraid that Finn could be hurt badly and feeling all alone, because the foster-brother she grew up with just doesn't want to believe her warnings. And let's be honest: I get how Finn must be feeling, but he is a douche around his mommy dearest, ignoring his sister, his girlfriend and the rest of the world. Not impressive. But then there are moments, I'm not impressed with Gin's actions [or lack thereof], either. I can only chalk up her missing the overall picture for so long to her emotional distress, because, come on, there are clues galore. But yeah, I admit she is emotionally challenged here. And although I think Gin shouldn't have overlooked the most obvious cues, I still didn't see all of which was coming. Nope. Especially since J.
