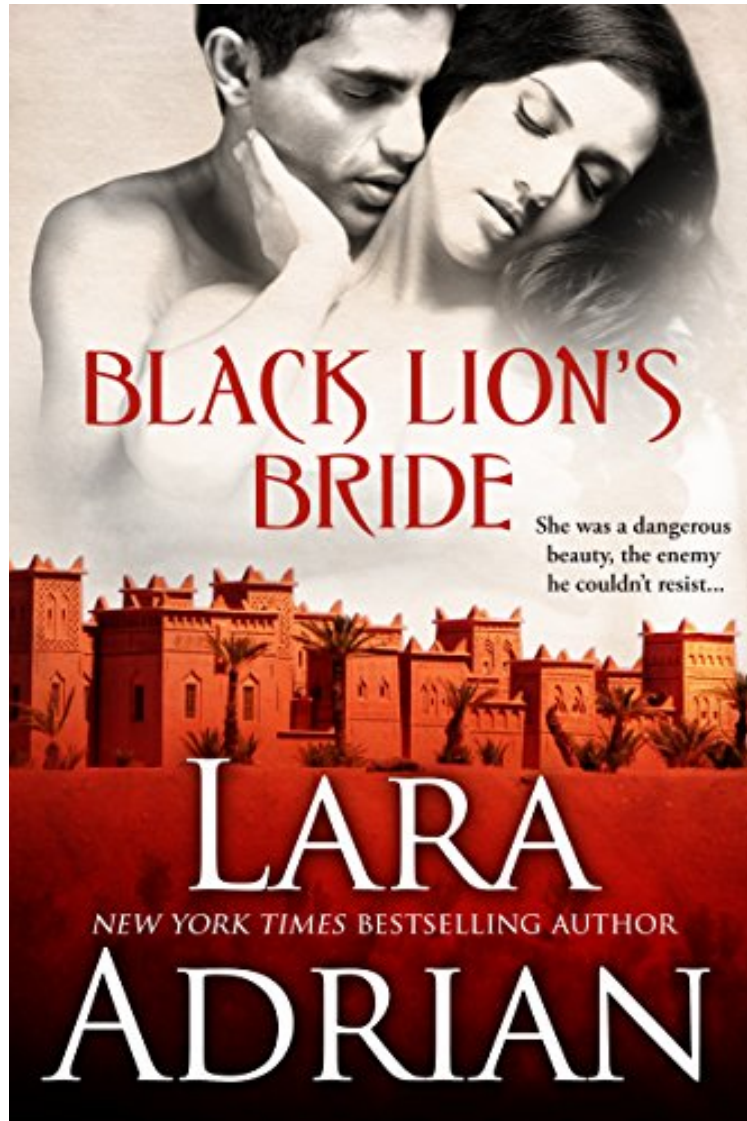

What is exactly the idea of the book? A question I asked myself upon finishing it.The author may have done some research but as a Syrian, I happen to know

about the history, geography and culture of my homeland. I am trying to be objective but really there were moments where I had to laugh because of the weakness of the story plot. For example, Zaheera is intimate with Sebastian but still she prays the five times! She disappeared for three month and then her skin gets back its original "porcelain" color! In a country like Syria, so many civilizations came in contact and lived together for a very long time so people are not all brown and dark. I myself have a very fair skin and I never got brown by the Syrian sun and I am still an Arab. However, what really angered me is that the book suggests that the Crusades are the good guys, while we "the land owners" are ruthless and uncivilized. The only positive Arab characters were Abdul (who dies in the beginning of the book) and Zaheera (who turns out to be not an Arab). I liked the love story between her and Sebastian. I also liked Sebastian, too. He was loyal to his oath and to his king, while Zaheera was not loyal to her "clan". Moreover, she is supposed to be highly trained and an excellent fighter but in most cases she stood there and did not know what to do. I am sorry that I read this book. The idea was really good and it started well but then it was spoiled with wrong information and a weird twist to justify the end. At the very end the author explains about her research and I found it actually good, but I did not see that research in the story. It would have been better. I am sure it was possible for their love to succeed even if they belong to different races and religions but not in the way the author chose.
