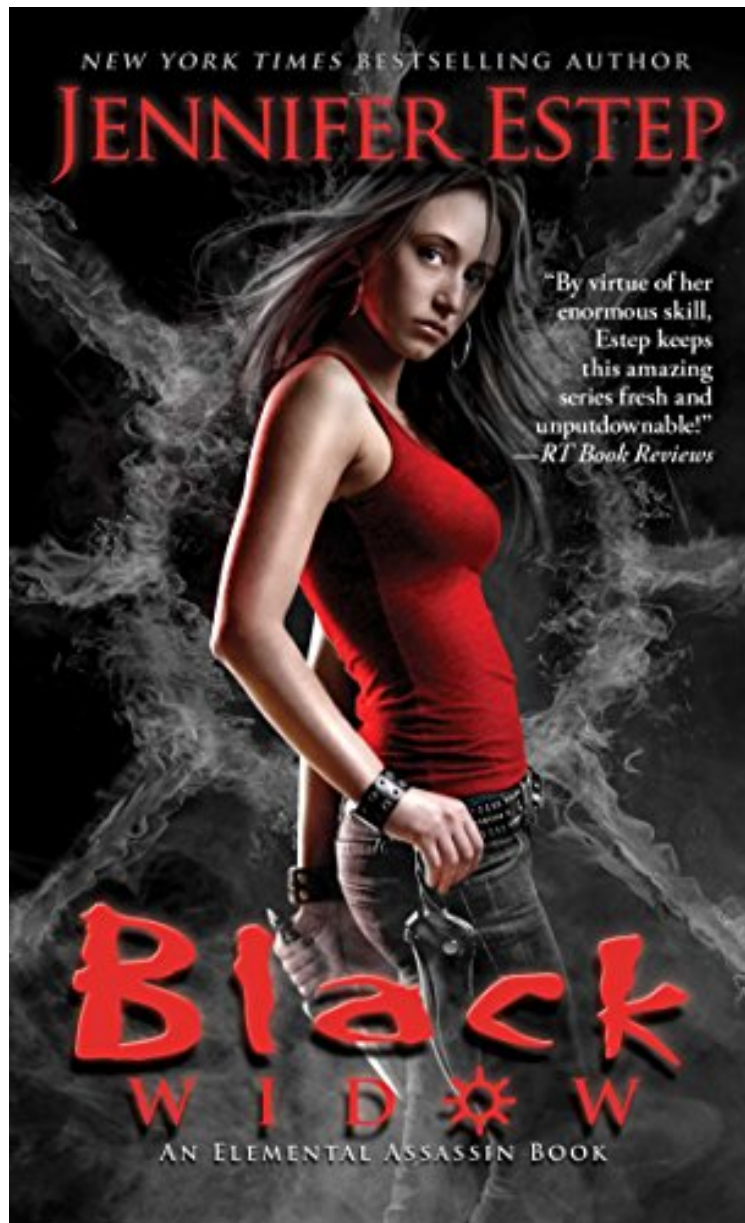

So if you're new to the series, I strongly recommend to start with Spider's Bite and stop reading here.ReviewAlthough J. Estep has surprised me time and again with new and excellently developed stories and foes, I admit I didn't think it possible that she could shock me like that with the pure awesomeness of the Spider's last adventure. This is by far the best of the Spider's books and that is saying a lot.Firstly there is the incredible nefarious antagonist. Madeleine Monroe is so cunning, I was wondering for a long time, how Gin and her friends could possibly untangle themselves from her machinations. Actually, I was sitting on the edge of my seat for a long time, because M. M. Monroe is good at what she's doing, how good her plotting is, reveals itself only when Gin and friends are already entangled and none sees a way out. And as I said in the last book's review: the better the adversary, the better the Spider. So when the traps around her and her loved ones have snapped shut, no way out to see whatsoever, Gin does what she is best at [well, besides killing people in an efficient way]: she gets very cool, very patient and very determinedly sets her own play in motion. And what an excellent plan she devises... Assassin or not, she is a good character to read about and I like it that she evolved over the series without ever losing her snark or her dangerousness. And even though her friends were a target because of her, there is never even the question of loosening the ties between any one of them. That made me ridiculously happy for Gin, because this is something she didn't have most of her life and craved so dearly.So this book shows Gin at her worst and at her best and brims with politics and incredibly well written fights, magical and other. The plot is a bit of an intricate game of chess with incredibly high stakes and a fitting and very worthy showdown. I admired Gin all the more for being at a disadvantage a great many times, yet rattle Madeleine Monroe and her flunkies time and again. The end is absolutely satisfying, if a bit surprising [but that is a good thing] and the last sentences made it into my Top Five coolest last sentences in a book. And even better, it's clear that Gin's life yet again takes a totally new and unexpected turn [well, at least unexpected by her] and that will provide material for great new stories.
