What I can tell you, is that Milly is back, her intentions as unclear as ever, and she has stuff to reveal that makes even Rylee shiver. Oh and Milly is not the only one to spring more and more and even darker prophecies on Rylee. Really, the outlook is kind of totally bleak for Rylee and the rest of the world. Not to mention the creepy and cruel vampires who now have stopped playing nice at all and will stop at nothing to force Rylee to help them to get or secure the throne. Really, this series never was of the "light and fun" variety. Rylee suffered a lot, even before the series' start and never has more than mere moments of peace, safety and reprieve. But with each book, everything gets even darker. So: this series is not for the faint of heart [not to talk about the usual amount of gore and splatter when fighting demons and other nasties]. But then, it also feels a bit like one of the greek tragedies of old and without a lot at stake, a lot of loss, there's probably no real heroine. But still, it was hard at times to read what is thrown at Rylee and even so I totally admire her, I fear that the biggest losses are yet to come [you know what I mean if you read the book]. This is again a wonderful installment in this outstanding series and the only reason, I gave four instead of five stars [and complaining on a high level here], is that it felt too short. Yes, the salvage is closed, the imminent case finished, but the book is nevertheless just a kind of warm-up of what is yet to come. And by the way: I so will cheer, when Rylee gets the vampires what they deserve. Boy are they a nasty kind!
