When Scarlett gets Dante drunk in the first chapter, just to mess with him, I found it pretty entertaining (and was glad not to be at the receiving end of her scorn.) But first of all - it's ridiculous to sell this book on its own. Half the story is missing, and you guessed it, because it's in book 2. Reading one without the other makes no sense. Anyway, the book has everything and plenty of it. Pain and passion, love and hatred, happiness and trauma. So much of it, at times I wondered how anyone could think of such a twisted and at times messed up story. But I immensely enjoyed it.
