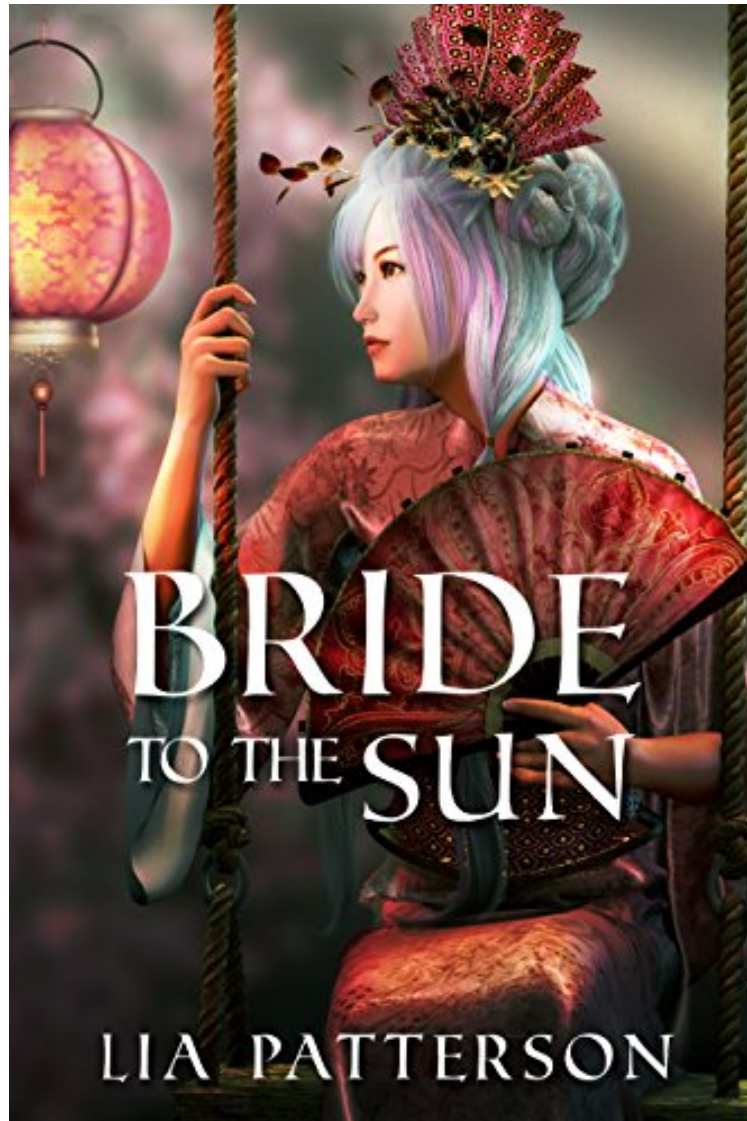

The plot is well thought out and the characters believable, but what I really like about this book is its humour. In some novels the protagonists all behave dead serious, the villain makes long speeches before he acts so the hero has enough time to rescue the fainting lady, and magic solves all the problems inherent to the author's plot! Not in Lias novel - Shay thinks she knows exactly what she wants in life - to be a bride to the sun - but then finds out there are more paths she can choose from. Medyr has to deal with Shay's headstrong behavior and is torn in between being irritated and attracted to her at the same time. The villain thinks it's all like a game of chess but finds out Shay has a few surprises for him. After the first page I could not put it down. It contains a wonderful heroine, intricate worldbuilding and a gripping plot that keeps the reader on the edge of their seat. The book is set in a fantasy equivalent of an ancient Chinese or Korean court, full of intrigue and magic. It opens with the heroine stripped of her position and ripped from her chosen life as an acolyte in the temple of the sun due to the reported deeds of her murdered father. She is awarded as a concubine to a barbarian visitor to the court. Said barbarian is both good looking and honorable, an honour which in his culture includes not taking a concubine, and certainly not against her will. The growing attraction between the two, the mystery of the murdered father, the culture clash between the barbarians and the culture of the nation, all combine to weave a gripping tale of intrigue and personal integrity.
