And no, it is not that I finally finished the novel on the third attempt, because it was so bad. It is rather the opposite actually: it was my third time reading this story, as it is one of my

absolute favorite books - ever. Dearest Clementine has everything I love in a novel and so much more. It definitely classifies as new adult since the characters are in their early twenties and attend University. I won't judge you for thinking that this is "just another college-new-adult novel" because this was my first impression too after reading the blurb. But believe me when I say that this novel is way more than that. The storyline has real depths and the characters are very well thought through. The story is funny, romantic, serious and also a little angsty. Clem is a girl after my liking. I consider myself closed off too, especially when it comes to the male species in this world, although I have different reasons than her. Like Clem, I have a good friend who often tells me not to be so bitchy on a night out: "Be nice!" Yeah... No. :D Since I can identify myself with Clem really well, I had a deeper connection to the book altogether, which I really liked. "You can't stand the heat? Then stay out of the kitchen." Then there is Gavin Murphy... There are not enough words and expressions in the English or German language that will do his character justice. Gavin is smart, funny, kind, understanding, honest, loyal and sexy as hell. All of those qualities and more qualify him to be in my top-3-list of book boyfriends: "I'm doing this in the name of academics. You need inspiration? You're looking at it. Ich mochte Clem von Anfang an. Ich hatte in der Beschreibung (oder in einer Rezension) schon den Hinweis auf "shes acting like a bitch" gelesen. Nachdem was Clem alles passiert ist finde ich es verständlich, dass sie die meisten Leute ausschließt und jedem der ihr zu nahe kommt erstmal einen Spruch vom Latz knallt. Der Einzige der ihre Mauern durchbrechen kann ist Gavin. Ich fand es teilweise recht lustig, dass Clem nicht merkt wie weit die Freundschaft zu Gavin geht und habe deshalb laut gelacht als er ihr sagt "it might be shocking for you, but we're dating for weeks" (oder so ähnlich).
